# Empty Cartridges Can Open Doors

For a child in a wheelchair, simply opening a door or turning on a light switch can be a challenge. But with a trained Susquehanna Service Dog, individuals with disabilities can overcome many such obstacles to lead fulfilled lives at home and in the community.

### What is "Susquehanna Service Dogs"?

A program of Keystone Children & Family Services (KC&FS), Susquehanna Service Dogs (SSD) trains Service and Hearing Dogs so that children & adults with disabilities can become more independent. SSD also provides Keystone Therapy Dogs to assist in counseling sessions, post-trauma intervention, cheer-up visits, etc.

### Why empty cartridges?

Most businesses discard empty inkjet and toner cartridges. But now, thanks to Keystone's partnership with Higher Information Group (Harrisburg Copiers) your empty cartridges can be easily recycled to generate much needed funds to support Susquehanna Service Dogs.

### Why does SSD need funds?

It costs about \$20,000 to properly breed, raise and train a service dog, and it costs approximately \$75 an hour to provide a Keystone Therapy Dog. Although SSD receives modest funding from The United Way, this Keystone program is dependent



upon substantial public support to continue the life-altering work its highly skilled dogs perform every day.

### How can I help?

You can help by collecting all used toner and inkjet cartridges in your on-site receptacle or one provided by Keystone. Higher Information Group (Harrisburg Copiers) or other Keystone volunteers will collect cartridges on a scheduled basis and ship them to the recycling center. The proceeds from the cartridge recycling will help fund SSD's vital mission.
